RACHEL: (LOOKING AT JAMIE, WHILE OPENING A BOTTLE OF ALCOHOL)

JAMIE: (PHONE STOPS RINGING, TURNS TO RACHEL)

Sometimes I wish my parents didn't care so much. It's not like they really care anyways; they just want me around to be a live in babysitter for Graham. (Jamie reaches her hand out for the bottle) Here, let me have the first. (Takes bottle and drinks).

RACHEL: (HANDING BOTTLE OVER)  
Ok, but not too much this time, I don't want you puking on me again!  
(Laughs)

JAMIE: (LAUGHING WITH RACHEL)  
Yeah, sorry about that again.

Scene fades out as camera pulls away.
